Anja Kaiser, based in Leipzig, is a German graphic designer and researcher.

Her wilfully feminist commitment is embedded in club culture, the academic field, teaching and support groups where her practice as a graphic designer benefits feminist or queer initiatives, such as the cyber-feminist event *dgtl fmnsn* or clubbing festivals Balance and Cry Baby.

Her monographic exhibition “*Undisciplined Toolkit*” features commissioned and more personal artistic work, all presented by Anja Kaiser as empowerment visuals.

Her clearly multimedia work explores the traditional boundaries set by graphic design where Anja Kaiser breaches the heteronormative, misogynist and neoliberal visual codes to speak out against the invisibilisation strategies of marginalised groups in order to trigger a beneficial overthrow of the perspectives in favour of structural changes.

The strong presence of typography reflects the importance of writing in Anja Kaiser’s work. This writing engages against oblivion and invisibilisation of womxn, queer, racialized groups in the history of contemporary society and claims solidarity, collaboration and social responsibility as pillars of equality.

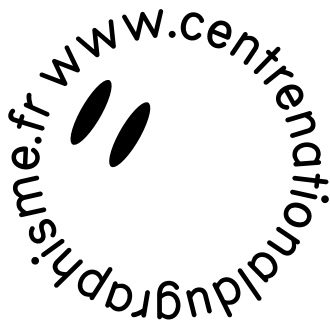
